

1. Recommended - these are the recommended releases from pretrial services. They do not call them this anymore, it is merely administrative releases. So, essentially they are the same as the administrative ORs contained in the second table. The Recommended are now included in the Felony and Misdemeanor totals in the administrative ORs in the second table.

2. Administrative ORs are OR release by Pretrial Services.

3. The Felony and Misdemeanor ORs for Administrative Releases are contained in the totals for Felony and Misdemeanor in the top table.

4. The top table for Felony and Misdemeanors includes the following OR releases: Recommended, Court Ordered, and Administrative (Pretrial)

5. Court Ordered include 72-hour releases and cannot be separated.

6. Walkthru releases are by order of the court. For example, an attorney files a motion to quash the warrant and at the hearing the Court grants the motion to quash. Pretrial documents that as booked and released that same day by order of the Court.

7. In order to determine the Court-ordered releases for Felony and Misdemeanors in the top table, you subtract the administrative ORs in the second table.
